GAME NOTES AND CAPSULES

TEAM - Defense

This season the Buccaneers have allowed 229 total rushing yards, the third-fewest allowed through five games in NFL history. Since the start of the 2019 season, the Buccaneers have allowed 5.20 yards per play, the seventh-lowest mark in the NFL. Since the start of the 2019 season, the Buccaneers have allowed 72.9 rushing yards per game and a rushing average of 3.38 yards – each the lowest mark in the NFL.

During that span, Tampa Bay has held 30-of-37 opponents under 100 rushing yards, the most in the NFL. Since the start of the 2019 season, Tampa Bay has 105.0 sacks, tied for the third-most in the NFL during that span. Since the start of the 2019 season, the Buccaneers have 61 takeaways, the fourth-most in the NFL during that span. Tampa Bay has scored 265 points off takeaways since the start of the 2019 season, the most in the NFL during that time. Since the start of the 2019 season, the Buccaneers have held opponents to a 38.3 percent third-down conversion rate, the 9th lowest mark in the league.

WR ANTONIO BROWN

- Caught seven passes for 124 yards and two touchdowns against Miami.
- Brown's first catch of the game was the 900th of his career, coming in his 143rd career game, surpassing Pro Football Hall of Famer Marvin Harrison as the fastest player to reach 900 receptions in NFL history.
- Brown now has 12,071 receiving yards in 143 career games, becoming the third-fastest player to reach 12,000 yards and one of only five players to reach 12,000 receiving yards in less than 150 career games (Julio Jones, 125; Jerry Rice, 142; Torry Holt, 146 and Andre Johnson, 146).
- Brown now has 82 career touchdown receptions, surpassing Art Powell and Steve Smith (81 each) and tying Anquan Boldin, Jimmy Graham and Reggie Wayne (82 each) for the 24th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Brown now has 19 career games with multiple touchdown receptions, tied with teammate Rob Gronkowski for the most such games among active players, the most such games since 2010 and tied for the ninth-most such games in NFL history.
- Brown now has 45 career games with at least 100 receiving yards, the second-most among active players and the second-most since 2010 (Julio Jones, 59) and tied for the 15th-most in NFL history.
- Brown now has 14 career games with at least 100 receiving yards and multiple touchdown catches, the most such games among active players and the sixth-most such games in NFL history.
- The five players ahead of him are Jerry Rice (27), Randy Moss (26), Marvin Harrison (22), Terrell Owens (17) and Don Maynard (16) – all of whom are in the Pro Football Hall of Fame.
- Brown has caught a pass in each of the past 141 games played, the longest active streak in the NFL and the 19th-longest streak in NFL

WR MIKE EVANS

- Caught six passes for 113 yards and two touchdowns against Miami.
- Since entering the league in 2014, Evans ranks second in the league in receiving touchdowns (65), trailing only teammate Antonio Brown. Evans also ranks third in the league in receiving yards (8,659), trailing only Julio Jones and DeAndre Hopkins.
- During that time frame, Evans' 30 100-receiving yard games are the fourth-most in the NFL, while his 14 games with multiple receiving touchdowns are the second-most in the NFL, trailing only teammate Antonio Brown's 16 such contests.
- Since 2014, Evans has nine games with at least 100 receiving yards and multiple touchdown catches, the second-most such games in the NFL during that span, trailing only teammate Antonio Brown

WR CHRIS GODWIN

Caught seven passes for 70 yards against Miami. With his totals against the Dolphins, Godwin now has 273 career receptions surpassing Vincent Jackson (268) for the 10th-most receptions yards in franchise history.
