#### Dan QUINN 3<sup>rd</sup> Year—2016

Replaced Mike Smith after 7 seasons in 2015---16<sup>th</sup> HC in Falcon history. QUINN Was the Seattle Seahawks defensive coordinator for the last two seasons (2013-14). Seattle led the League allowing 270.4 yards per game, 15.2 points per game, and 178.8 passing yards per game while holding opponents to 91.6 rushing pergame. In 2014, Quinn's defense led the NFL in scoring defense (15.9), total defense (267.1), and passing yards (185.6), while ranking third in rushing yards (81.5). The Seahawks also boasted the League's top defensive unit in 2013, en route to a win over the Denver Broncos in Super Bowl XLVIII.
